Concept of tithing pre-dates Jewish law Genesis 14:17-20; Genesis 28:15-22

Tithing became Jewish law as part of the national tax system.

Lev. 27:30; Numbers 18:26; Deut. 14:24; 2 Chronicles 31:5; Malachi 3:8-10
