The first scripture seeming to prohibit female ministers:

1 Corinthians 14:34-35

- 1. No one believes this
- 2. Women are given permission to pray and prophecy in 1 Cor. 11:1

"Wives must not disrupt worship, talking when they should be listening, asking questions that could more appropriately be asked of their husbands at home. God's Book of the law guides our manners and customs here. Wives have no license to use the time of worship for unwarranted speaking."

1 Corinthians 14:34-35 (MSG)

Second scripture seeming to prohibit female ministers:

1 Timothy 2:11-15

- 1) All learning must be done in submission.
- 2) Gynē can be translated woman or wife.
- 3) "Usurp authority" means to kill, dominate or master.
- 4) Saved through childbearing.

Limiting women in ministry doesn't make sense.
