Part 2: Covenant Relationships

What is a covenant? A covenant is a binding, mutually accepted agreement that manages the relationship between individuals or groups.

The old covenant was designed to bring about behavior change; The new covenant is designed to bring about personal relationship. Hebrews 8:10-13

The key to covenant relationship is found in the Hebrew word hesed.

Hesed is the dependable & enthusiastic commitment, kindness and support received by being in covenant with someone. "The <u>steadfast love</u> of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." Lamentations 3:22-23

"The LORD is gracious and full of compassion, Slow to anger and great in <u>mercy</u>." Psalm 145:8

"For the mountains shall depart and the hills be removed, but my <u>kindness</u> shall not depart from you, nor shall my covenant of peace be removed," says the LORD, who has mercy on you. Isaiah 54:10
