Hebrew for LOVINGKINDNESS: Hesed - Covenant Love

The prophet Isaiah wrote, *“Though the mountains be shaken, and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love (hesed) for you will not be shaken”*. (Isaiah 54:10)

Hesed is one of the most fundamental characteristics of God, consistent with what we know about His covenant nature.

Hesed is “**wrapping up in itself all the positive attributes of God: love, covenant faithfulness, mercy, grace, kindness, loyalty—in short, acts of devotion and loving-kindness that go beyond the requirements of duty,**” Bible scholar Darrell L. Bock.
