or present**

# How to Give a Prophecy

**-Do: Submit it to other mature believers**

**1 Corinthians 14:29**

**-Don't: Give parking lot prophecies**

**-Do: Give prophetic words in an orderly way**

**1 Corinthians 14:40**

**-Don't: Cause confusion**

# Tongues

**The gift of tongues is saying what God is saying in a foreign or unknown language.**

**Interpretation of tongues is the supernatural ability to reveal the meaning behind a message in tongues.**

**Prophecy is preferred over

**TONGUES + INTERPRETATION =  
PROPHECY**

## **How to say what God says:**

- 1. Ask to be filled with the Holy Spirit.**
- 2. Receive prayer from someone who already walks in these spiritual gifts.**
- 3. Step out in faith when you feel led.**
