

How can we be generous?

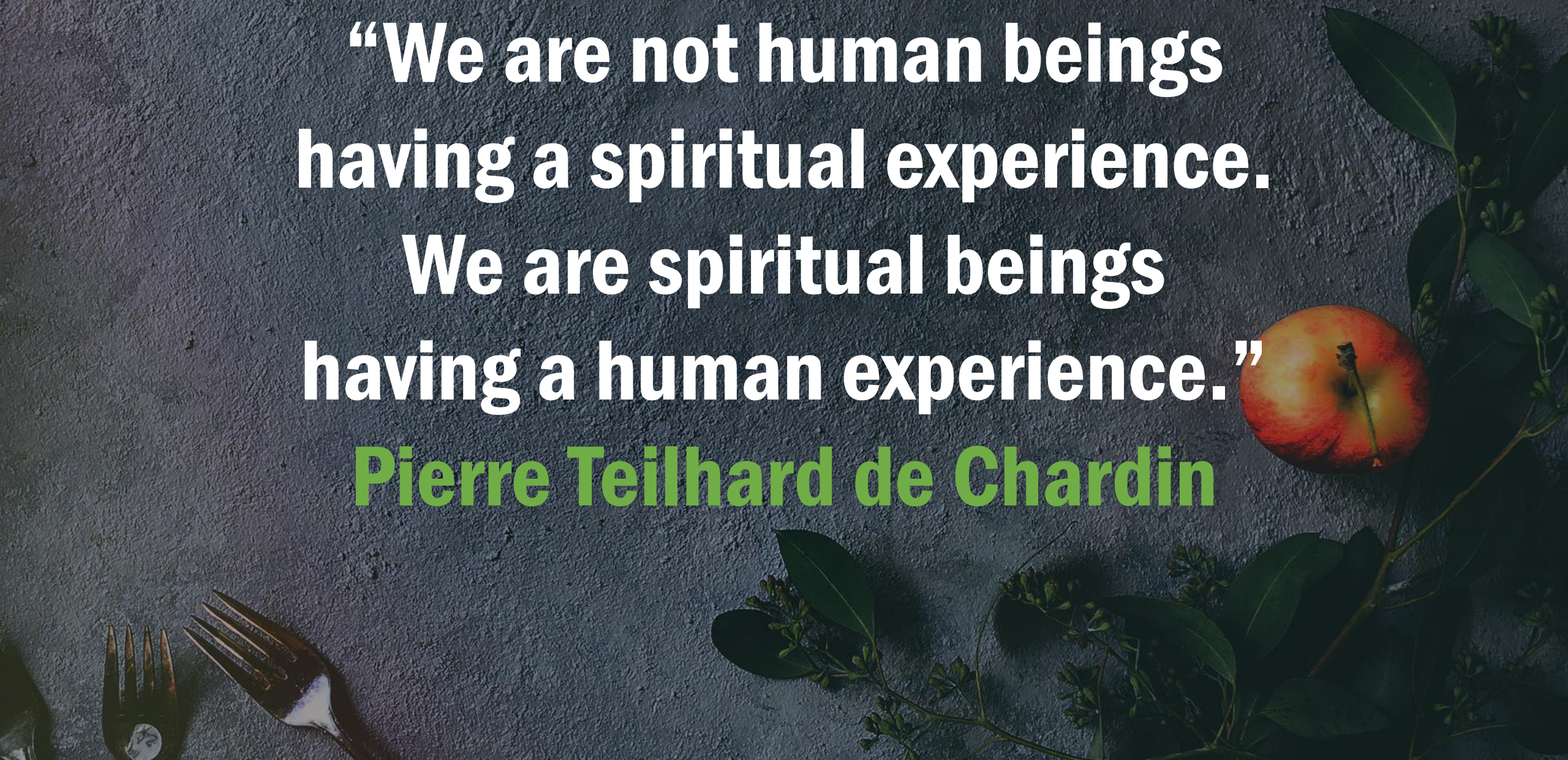
1. Recognize that this life is temporary.
